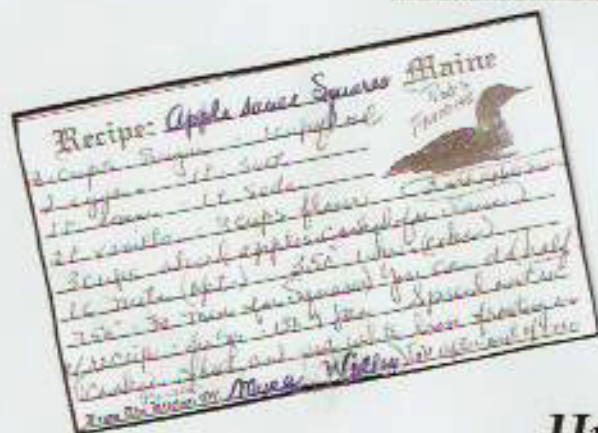

We thank you for anything you could add to our new collection.

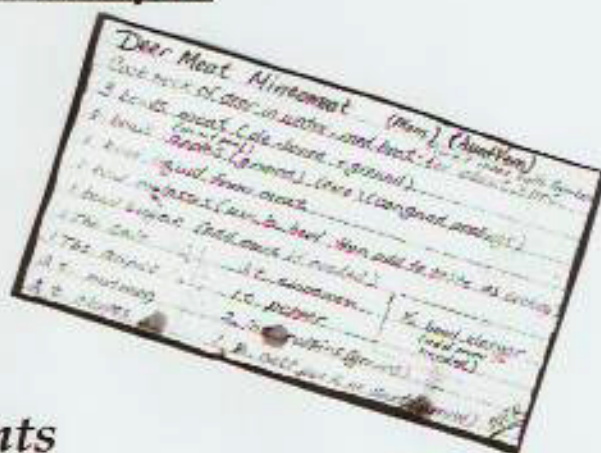
